**Mark Hunter:  
Owner/VP/General  
Manager/Head Coach**

Mark began his 12<sup>th</sup> season as Owner, Vice President and General Manager of the London Knights Hockey Club. However, after his brother, Dale, was selected as the new Head Coach of the Washington Capitals, Mark immediately stepped into the role of Head Coach of the team as well. Mark currently oversees all daily business and hockey operations of the London Knights, in addition to his head coaching responsibilities.

Since taking over the London Knights in 2000, Mark has made a major impact on the organization. Under Mark's guidance, the Knights have led the OHL in attendance for seven consecutive seasons. In 2003, Mark was recognized for his efforts being awarded with the Canadian Hockey League Executive of the Year Award. Mark is also responsible for developing the London Knights Charitable Foundation, which has donated over one million dollars to local charities since May 2000. Mark is also a member of the OHL Competitions Committee and plays a key role in providing feedback for rules, style of play, officiating and off-ice seminars.

On the ice, Mark has made a significant impact as well. Mark has drafted, developed, and traded for many talented players during his time with the Knights. Several of his players have been selected with the 1<sup>st</sup> overall draft pick in the NHL Entry Draft, including Rick Nash (1<sup>st</sup> overall, 2002), Patrick Kane (1<sup>st</sup> overall, 2007), and John Taveras (1<sup>st</sup> overall, 2009). In addition, former London Knight, Corey Perry, was awarded with the NHL Hart Trophy as league Most Valuable Player for the 2010-2011 season.

Drafted in the First Round of the 1981 NHL Entry Draft by the Montreal Canadiens, Mark played 12 seasons in the NHL, winning a Stanley Cup with the Calgary Flames in 1989. Along with Montreal and Calgary, Mark also suited up for the St. Louis Blues, Hartford Whalers, and Washington Capitals during his time in the NHL.

### Dale Hunter: Owner/President/ Assistant Coach

Dale began his 12<sup>th</sup> season as the Owner, President, and Head Coach of the London Knights Hockey Club. On November 28, 2011, Dale was named the new Head Coach of the Washington Capitals, stepping down as Head Coach of the Knights. Currently, Dale is still very involved in the organization, holding the positions of Team President and Owner.

While Head Coach of the London Knights, Dale compiled an overall record of 451-189-23-24. To date, he has the best Winning Percentage in the history of the OHL at .691. Dale also became the fastest coach in the history of the OHL to reach both the 300 and 400 win plateau. During the 2003-2004 season, Dale was named the CHL Coach of the Year. The next season, the Knights won their 1<sup>st</sup> Memorial Cup Championship, compiling an overall record of 59-7-2-0, setting numerous CHL records in the process. During his time as coach of the London Knights, the team won 50 or more games three times and finished 1<sup>st</sup> in the OHL four times.

Prior to purchasing the London Knights, Dale served as Director of Player Development for the Washington Capitals in 1999-2000. As a player, Dale spent 19 seasons in the National Hockey League suiting up for the Quebec Nordiques, Washington Capitals and Colorado Avalanche. His # 32 was retired by the Washington Capitals in March of 2000. Hunter is a graduate of the OHL, having played for both the Kitchener Rangers and Sudbury Wolves.

**Misha Donskov:  
Assistant General  
Manager/Assistant Coach**

Misha Donskov is currently in his 3<sup>rd</sup> year with the London Knights organization as an Assistant Coach and his 1<sup>st</sup> year as the team's Assistant General Manager. Prior to his work with the Knights, Misha spent eight years working in the National Hockey League with the Columbus Blue Jackets and the Atlanta Thrashers within Hockey Development Programming, Community Development, Fan Development, Marketing, and Hockey Operations. Donskov was also involved in Pro Scouting with the Atlanta Thrashers. Additionally, Donskov spent six years working for Cardinal Health, a large fortune 19 medical device company, where he was involved in various roles of increasing responsibility within finance, sales, and sales management.

In his role as Assistant General Manager and Assistant Coach, Donskov is responsible for coordinating and assisting with all aspects of Hockey Operations including: arranging the London Knights mini camp, training camp, team travel, player contracts, and scouting schedules each year. He also is responsible for assisting Mark Hunter with scouting and player personnel decisions. Additionally, Misha will work closely with Marketing Manager, Natalie Wakabayashi, to coordinate team and media relations including news releases, game notes, and press conferences. From a coaching standpoint, Donskov will support Head Coach Mark Hunter with all aspects of on and off ice development of the London Knights players including working with the forwards, the development of young draft picks and prospects within the system, skills/player development, video pre-scout and analysis, practice planning, and game strategy.

Donskov holds a Masters Degree in Kinesiology with a Specialization in Coaching Education from The University of Western Ontario. Additionally, Misha holds an undergraduate degree in Business Administration/Finance from Miami (Ohio) University. Donskov played at the junior, university, and semi professional level in Canada, the United States, Sweden and Norway. During the summer months, Misha and his family own and operate Donskov Hockey Development, LLC. in Columbus, Ohio.


## Dylan Hunter: Assistant Coach



Dylan Hunter is currently in his 1<sup>st</sup> year as an Assistant Coach with the London Knights Hockey Club. Prior to joining the Knights coaching staff, Dylan played five years of professional hockey in the AHL and ECHL. During his time as a professional, Dylan played over 300 games collecting 60 goals, 115 assists and 175 points to go along with 225 PIM.

Prior to his career as a professional, Dylan was a member of the London Knights from 2001-2006 where he played in 315 games, setting the franchise record for number of games played. During his time as a Knight, Dylan scored 106 goals, while adding 263 assists to go along with 240 PIM. Dylan was an instrumental part of the team's 2005 Memorial Cup Championship, playing on a line with Rob Schremp and David Bolland. Dylan was named captain of the Knights for the 2005-2006 season. In 2004, Dylan was drafted in the 9<sup>th</sup> Round (273<sup>rd</sup> overall) of the NHL Entry Draft by the Buffalo Sabres.

In his role as Assistant Coach, Dylan is responsible for assisting Head Coach Mark Hunter and the London Knights coaching staff with all aspects of on and off-ice development of the London Knights players. Dylan focuses on working with the forwards, the development of the young draft picks and prospects within the system, skills/player development, video pre-scout and analysis, practice planning, and game strategy.

**Rob Ramage:  
Assistant Coach**

Rob Ramage is currently in his 1st season as Assistant Coach with the London Knights. After the mid-season departure of Dale Hunter to the Washington Capitals, Ramage stepped in to solidify the Knights coaching staff and take control of the defenseman. Prior to his work with the Knights, Ramage worked as a broker for A.G. Edwards for 14 years and for the St. Louis Blues during the 2009-2010 season as a Development Coach.

Ramage, a London, Ontario native, played three seasons with the Knights recording 44 goals and 136 assists for a total of 180 points. During the 1977-1978 season, Ramage received the Max Kaminsky Trophy as Top Defenseman in the OHL. His number five jersey was retired by the Knights and now hangs in the rafters at the John Labatt Centre.

Ramage was the 1st overall pick by the Colorado Rockies in the 1979 NHL Entry Draft. During his NHL career, Ramage won two Stanley Cups (with the Calgary Flames in 1989, and with the Montreal Canadiens in 1993) and made four all-star appearances in the process. Ramage was also captain of the Colorado Rockies from 1981-1982, as well as the Toronto Maple Leafs from 1989-1991. He played in a total of 1044 games during his career for 8 different teams, tallying 139 goals and 425 assists.

Ramage's son, John, is a prospect in the Calgary Flames organization and is currently playing at the Collegiate level for the Wisconsin Badgers. John won Gold at the 2010 U20 World Junior Hockey Championships with Team USA and was named Captain of the team the following year for the 2011 U20 World Junior Hockey Championships.




